



Discipline Policy and Procedure

1. Policy Statement

We are committed to a policy of high expectations of our students as learners. We expect and encourage good behaviour from all students.

To support this expectation and ensure that the NW Academy remains an effective learning environment for others, allegations of inappropriate behaviour will be dealt with through this procedure.

2. Scope

This document sets out the code of conduct to which students are expected to adhere in return for being part of the NW Academy. It also sets out the procedure that should be followed where there is an allegation of a breach of discipline.

A breach of discipline may lead to action being taken against a student in line with the procedure. Repeated breaches, or a single serious breach, may result in a student being suspended or permanently dismissed.

This policy and procedure applies to all students, this includes students in the NW Academy, out on work placement, on social activities within accommodations, organised by the school and behaviour in community and any other project elements.

3. Students' Code of Conduct

The NW Academy expects each student to act in a manner that supports their learning and the learning of others.

1 Informal Stage

- Change of seat or isolation in the classroom
- Remove student from the class
